#### The Stevenage Festival of Arts and Leisure

The Stevenage Festival of Arts and Leisure is presenting for the first time on a large scale a collection of the town's vast reserves of amateur talent.

The Festival is being arranged under the auspices of the Arts Guild of Stevenage. Its Festival sub-committee has been working hard putting in place an action-packed week of events including concerts, musical shows, straight plays, displays of art, photography, sport and sculpture.

Their investigations have proved without a doubt that there is the talent and the will to succeed with such a venture.

"All the entertainment and spectacle during the week will be provided by Stevenage organisations – a wonderful showcase of talent," said the chairman of the Festival sub-committee, Arts Guild treasurer, Roy Mugridge.

Talent they found in abundance when they visited performing and artistic groups of many kinds, from magicians to sculptors, singers to stiltwalkers, poets to painters.

Enough talent to fill seven nights at the Gordon Craig Theatre with music, dance, laughter and drama. Enough talent to put on major exhibitions of 'home-grown' paintings and sculpture.

Finding the money to stage such an event in the current climate is a difficult task, which nevertheless continues with modest success.

Stevenage Arts Guild's vice chairman and Festival sub-committee member Ron Walker said: "The Festival will strengthen links between cultural and leisure groups in the town and underscore the benefits of community spirit"
